BCDP READY, VOTING BEGINS FEBRUARY 20!!!

The Bexar County Democratic Party is ready for the 2018 Primary Election: candidates were recruited and placed on the ballot; voting sites are secured and election judges trained; computers have been programmed and result software tested; plus, the other 101 logistical things to do for the primary are on track to be completed on-time.

We expect about 50,000 votes in the Democratic Primary. Typically, 65% of votes are cast by voters who are 65 years or older. That's why, in coordination with the Texas Democratic Party, we sent out VBM Applications to a large universe of seniors. Some seniors sent the application to the election department, received their actual ballot, and have already cast the first votes of this primary. Seniors Vote!!!



FEDERAL ELECTIONS, STOP TRUMP

Collectively, we led our local party to a PERFECT RECORD "25-0" last election cycle. We won all 25 countywide races because we recruited more volunteers than ever, registered more voters than ever, and raised more money than ever.

This year, our goal is to win everything AGAIN but with bigger vote margins. By racking up the numbers in Bexar County, we can help elect Democrats in CD 21, Congressional District 23, and Beto O'Rourke to the United States Senate. By sending more Democrats to Washington, we will stop Trump; and that is the No. 1 Priority of the Bexar County Democratic Party.

All three of these federal races are contested, and voters will decide on a nominee March 6. The candidates for United States Senate are Beto O'Rourke, Sema Hernandez, and Edward Kimbrough. It is currently represented by Republican Will Hurd (who votes with Trump 96% of the time), and the Democrats competing for the nomination are: Angela "Angie" Villescaz; Gina Ortiz Jones; Jay Hulings; Judy Canales; and Rick Trevino. This is one of the most exciting races in the Texas Democratic Primary and will likely result in a runoff to be decided in May.
